Dr. Evil Laboratories is a small company dedicated to creating the best software possible, at a price that everyone can afford. To keep our costs low (and to make our lives less complicated!) all of our software is shareware. Shareware is not copy protected and may be freely distributed. To receive full user support and documentation, you send the manufacturer (in this case us) a reasonable sum of money.

We truly believe that shareware is the best way to serve our customers. Those who want help and documentation can get it, and those who don't, won't. Those people who do pay for the documentation and support are also making a statement that they like our products, and that they wish to be aware of other products we develop.

Our first program that is in distribution now is Imagery!, a fantasy role-playing game for the Commodore 64 (or 128 in 64 mode). Imagery! is unique in that its success depends upon the response of its players. Not only can you play Imagery! adventures, you can create your own with the Adventure Designer.

Imagery!, as hinted at above, is not copy-protected and is open to your inspection. It is, however, copyrighted. We felt that in order to preserve the playability of Imagery!, modifications should be made only through us. If a player finds a bug or wishes something changed, we will take the responsibility of correcting Imagery! in a way that all registered Imagery! players will be aware. To facilitate this, we have established a club just for Imagery! players named Imagination. Imagination is the center about which all Imagery! activities revolve. The Image, the official Imagery! newsletter, will inform all Imagination members of Imagery! happenings, updates, new adventures, and (gasp!) bug fixes.

We invite you to become a part of the Imagery! excitement. For \$10.00, you will receive the Imagery! boot disk; which contains all of the necessary software to create, equip, and store characters; the first adventure, Beneath Mount Imagery; the Imagery! Player's Manual; and a one-year membership in Imagination (which includes a one-year subscription to The Image).

In the near future, Dr. Evil Labs will be releasing several products, including a blindingly-quick macro assembler that is completely memory-resident, a full-featured disk examiner/editor, and several other useful utilities. Please contact us for further information.
